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Re: Kenosha Bradford H.S. Red Devil Invitational- Saturday April 22, 2017

History: When the new Bradford H.S. opened in the fall of 1980, Bradford hosted a boys only indoor relay meet for 14 years from 1981 to 1994. Starting in 1995, the meet format was changed to a boys only invitational and ran for another 17 years until 2011. At that time, varsity meets were just starting to be held on 200 meter tracks and the meet was cancelled due to a lack of interest. We are now reinstating the invitational to a coed outdoor event with the building of our new Mary D. Bradford Stadium. This will be our 32nd Annual Red Devil Invitational, which for the first time will be held on our new outdoor track. We are very excited to bring back this event which was not held for the past 5 years. We are pleased to have the 3 Kenosha and 2 Racine public schools for the new start and continuation of our Red Devil Invitational.

General Information:

- Providing Fully Automatic Timing by PT Timing
- Allowing 3 individual varsity entries per event + 2 relay team entries per event (1 Varsity and 1 JV)
- 3 Varsity entries and 3 JV entries in shot put, discus, long jump, and triple jump
- Limiting this invitational to 6 boys and 6 girls teams

Facility: The track was installed by AFS. It is a Seal-Flex Beynon polyurethane surface. The Mary D. Bradford Stadium track has nine 42" lanes on the curves and on the straights. Long and triple jump pits are at the southeast corner of the stadium and can be contested in either the north or south direction. The pole vault runway extends east/west on the south end of the track with a box at both ends. The high jump pad is located on the north end of the track. The shot and discus pads are located outside the fence on the southeast corner of the stadium. No Locker rooms available.

Entries Limits: Athletes may compete in 4 events as per WIAA rules. An athlete who competes in a JV relay CANNOT also compete in ANY varsity relay, but CAN compete in ANY varsity individual event. *Coaches will also need to list their relay team individual members for both varsity and JV.

Submit entry: Entries must be received by 12:00PM on Thursday April 20, 2017. All entries must be online at www.pttiming.com. Coaches can access the online entry system by going to the 'upcoming events' page on their website. Teams that fail to meet the deadline will be charged a late fee of \$50.00, which must be paid prior to the start of the meet in order for their entries to be accepted. Entries will open one week and 2 days on Thursday April 13th prior to the deadline at Noon (12:00 CST) on Thursday April 20th. Entries/heat sheets will be posted online in advance.

Scratches: Please limit your scratches as much as possible, but since it is Easter break, we will allow for only a maximum of 3 scratches with replacements. Also, you may not scratch an athlete from one event and then add them to another event.

Scoring: We will score the meet in two ways. One way will be by city for a combined Kenosha score and a combined Racine score, separate for boys and girls. The second way will be the traditional way by school, for both boys and girls. Individual events will be scored with places 1-5. (8-6-4-2-1). Relay events will be scored with places 1-4. (8-6-4-2).

- Awards:** Specially designed Red Devil Invitational Medals by Jostens will be given for places 1st-2nd- 3rd, including relays. Also Championship Trophies will be given out to each of the three 1st place city teams for boys and girls. Awards can be picked up in the press box after the meet.
- CAT:** Colleen Winans, Bradford's Certified Athletic Trainer will be on site.
- Concessions:** A concession stand will be available throughout the meet. Teams will receive meal tickets for their coaches for lunch at the concession stand.
- Tents:** Team tents may be set up on the grass area on the southwest/northwest side of the stadium's main bleachers.
- Info. Packets:** Pick up team packet upon arrival in the southeast team room on the track side of the concession building.
- Spikes:** 1/4" pyramid spikes are the maximum allowed. NO pins or Christmas Tree spikes allowed. Spikes will be checked during event check in. HJ/LJ/TJ/PV surface is the same as the track.
- Clerking:** Running event check in will at the start of the 100 Meters on the north end of the track. A table will be set up near the starting line to pick up hip numbers.
- Announcer:** Jerry Munia, a retired track coach from Oak Creek HS, will announce. Tom Roders, a former Bradford track coach (1975-1988) will assist.
- Results:** Results will be posted after each event is determined to be final. Meet results can be found at www.pttiming.com.
- Rest Rooms:** Located at the front of the concession building at the south end of the track at the entrance.
- T-Shirt Sale:** Bradford will be selling T-Shirts. Details will be sent out in advance.
- Admission:** Adults \$4.00, students \$3.00. Programs will be sold for \$1.00.
- Field Events:** We would like to have each school run one field event:
- Shot Put: Bradford Discus: Indian Trail
- Long Jump: Park Triple Jump: Tremper
- High Jump: Horlick
- If schools mutually want to trade running a field event, please let meet management know of that change. **Relay exchanges for the 400 & 800 relays will be covered by sprint coaches from all five schools.

- Long Jump: Boys followed by girls. Open pit. 4 jumps. No finals.
- Triple Jump: Girls followed by boys. Open pit. 4 jumps. No finals.
- (In both long and triple, Varsity and JV compete together)
- Shot Put: Boys followed by girls. Varsity and JV together. 4 throws. No Finals.
- Discus: Girls followed by boys. Varsity and JV together. 4 throws. No finals.
- 11:00 AM Track Events Begin: ALL EVENTS WILL BE RUN AS FINALS, WITH NO TRIALS

- 100/110 Meter IMH/HH Girls-Boys (2 Sections each)

- 800 Meter Relay* GV, BV, GJV, BJV (1 section each)
- 400 Meter Dash Girls-Boys (2 sections each)
- 400 Meter Relay* GV, BV, GJV, BJV (1 section each)
- 300 Meter LH/IMH Girls-Boys (2 Sections each)
- 800 Meter Run Girls-Boys (2 Sections each)
