Dear Coach:

Welcome to the 2017 Earl Gatzke Memorial Invitational. We will be using the Regional format for your entries. You may enter 28 athletes over the 14 individual events with no more than three (3) in any one event. Attached is a rolling time schedule. The 200 will be run only as a final in sections. Please enter your athletes online at www.pttiming.com. **Please be sure to fill all your events online.** Please print a copy of your entries in case there are any discrepancies. There will be no additions on the day of the meet. Remember that PTTiming will charge you a late fee if they need to reopen entries because the deadline was missed. Entries are due on Wednesday, April 19 at Noon.

Please note that the meet is on Friday, April 21. Starting time is 4:15 for this year's meet.

Other items of interest for the meet this year:

1. We will be using fully automated timing again this year. We are planning on having runners wear their hip number on their left hip.

 - Entries must be completed by visiting pttiming.com. To find your event, hover over *Schedule* and click on *All Upcoming Events*. If your event is not listed, please contact lindsey@pttiming.com.
 - Online entries must be completed 2 days prior to the event at NOON—to avoid confusion, the deadline is set at 11:59 am CST.
 - Meet entries open 1 week and 2 days prior to the deadline at noon.
 - If a coach misses the deadline, the coach should email info@pttiming.com to reopen the meet. The host school and/or violating school may incur a \$50 Late Entry Fee—PT Timing will make that decision, depending on the situation.

We have a seal-flex surface on the track and long, triple and high jump runways. Spike length for all areas will be 1/4 inch. All longer spikes will result in disqualification from that event. Spikes will be checked when each runner picks up their hip number. Concessions will be sold during the meet behind the bleachers. Hopefully, your season is progressing smoothly and the weather will cooperate on the 21st. See you then, and best of luck.

Spikes: ¼ inch spikes for all event except Shot Put and Discus

Results: Available shortly after the competition and also later that evening on www.pttiming.com

Scoring: Top 8 competitors and relays will score: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

Entries: Entries will be submitted on-line at www.pttiming.com. **Each team is allowed 28 individual entries (with a maximum of 3 in any one event) for the 14 individual events, and 1 relay per event. Check Entry Due Date**

Coaches Meeting: Will be held in the white garage at the end of the front straight meet at 3:30.

Hip Numbers: Will be located in the booster club building by the start of the 100 meters.

Event Results: Will be posted on the wall of the booster building near the hip number area as soon as they are available.

Scratches: All scratches are to be made at the coaches meeting prior to the meet. **NO ADDITIONS** the day of the competition. Substitutions can compete under the original competitor's name.

Concessions: Will be available in the building directly behind the bleachers on the front straight.

The Earl Gatzke Invitational Track Meet is dedicated to the memory of Tomah educator and coach, Earl Gatzke. Gatzke was a visible presence in Tomah athletics for 36 years, from the time he began teaching in 1946 until his retirement in 1982. Serving as an assistant football coach during his entire 36 years, and as head track coach from 1947 to 1971, Gatzke touched the lives of countless athletes and students. In 1982, Gatzke was honored by the Tomah Education Association and Tomah Area School District as "Teacher of the Year."

As track coach, Gatzke was instrumental in the planning and building of a cinder track in Tomah. As Tomah High School Athletic Director, Gatzke played an instrumental role in the development of the current E. J. McKean Track and Field. As both a coach and teacher, Earl Gatzke exemplified the commitment to educational and athletic excellence.
