GENERAL INFORMATION

1. We are happy to host the 19th Annual Parker Viking Girls' Track and Field Invitational. We'll start the meet promptly at 4:30 and will follow the included time schedule.
2. Locker room facilities at Monterey Stadium are available to all teams. Please do not leave items unattended as all teams will have access to these common areas.
3. A coaches meeting is scheduled at 4:00 in the press box at the stadium.
4. Each school will be allowed 4 entries in individual events and 1 entry in the relays.
5. Please remind your athletes that 1/4 inch spikes are to be used. We have a 9-lane seal flex all weather surface. All jump areas also have the same surface. The shot and discus areas are concrete. These areas and the pole vault area were recently upgraded.
6. Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the concession stand behind the stadium.
7. Contestants may compete in four events, no more than three of which may be either running or field.
8. High jump will start at 4' 0" with 2" raises until 3 or less remain, then 1" raises. (Five Alive).
9. Pole vault will start at 6' 0" with 6" raises until 3 or less remain, then 3" raises. (Five Alive).
10. Long & Triple jumps will have concurrent 1 hour 30 minute open pits and take 4 jumps only--all finals.
11. All Throwers will have 3 trial throws. The top 9 competitors will advance to the finals for 3 more throws. We will allow each competitor 2 cycles into the ring in trials. Finals will be 3 cycles. Discus finals will be first followed by shot final.
12. Medals will be awarded to first through fifth places in all individual events and first through third in all relay events. A coin flip will decide who receives which tied medal place. (All these ties will medal). Scoring for all individual events will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1, and relays will be scored one less than the number of teams competing.
13. Please enter your info at PTTIMING (www.pttiming.com).

• **Online entries must be completed 2 days prior to the event at NOON.** To avoid confusion, the deadline is 11:59 am CST.

• Meet entries open 1 week and 2 days prior to the deadline at noon.

• If a coach misses the deadline, the coach should email lindsey@pttiming.com to reopen the meet. The host school and/or violating school may incur a \$50 Late Entry Fee—PT Timing will make that decision, depending on the situation.
