Girls will Pole Vault, Shot Put and Triple Jump first and Boys will High Jump, Discus and Long Jump first.

4:00 3200 Meter Relay. Girls followed by Boys.
Running trials will be held in this order:
Girls 100, Boys 100, Boys 110 High Hurdles & Girls 100 High Hurdles.
*No trials in the 200-heats set for finals.

Running Finals: 100 HH Girls then 110 HH Boys and the remaining running events will follow in proper order.

1. One relay per event
2. 28 individual event entries for boys and girls

Other Info:

Spikes of 1/8" to 1/4" may be worn on all running and jumping events.

Weight circles are cement, flats only may be worn.

Heat winner and next fastest times to fill eight final spots will be determined in the trials of the 100, 100 and 110 hurdles. Top 9 places after trials in the shot put, discus, long jump & triple jump will make it to finals. Shot Put and discus will use a 1, 1, 1, format in trials and finals.

Boys will throw the discus first and Girls will throw the shot put then reverse. Shot and discus will start at 3:30.

Girls will pole vault first and Boys will high jump then reverse. High Jump and pole vault will start at 3:30.

Boys will long jump first followed by the girls. Girls will triple jump first followed by the girls.

Boys long jump trials – 3:30-4:30 Finals 4:45-5:15

Girls long jump trials – 5:30-6:30 Finals 6:45-7:15

Girls triple jump trials – 3:30-4:30 Finals 4:45-5:15

Boys triple jump trials – 5:30-6:30 Finals 6:45-7:15

Running event athletes must report to the clerk of course, located in the area behind the starting line on the north end of the track, on the second call for their events.

***ALL RUNNING EVENT ATHLETES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING THE PROPER HIP NUMBERS FOR EACH OF THEIR RACES FROM THE TENT NEAR THE CLERK OF COURSE AREA!**

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We ask that all teams set up their camps outside the track area and that **NO ONE GOES ON THE INFIELD EXCEPT THOSE COMPETITORS REPORTING TO THE CLERK OF COURSE! THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION!**

A certified athletic trainer will be on hand from the Aurora Sports Medicine Clinic.

Award envelopes can be picked up in the press box after completion of the meet. Results will be available at the finish line shortly after the completion of the meet and will also be posted on line at www.pttiming.com.
