ENTRY FEE: \$250.00 – if you have not paid please pay as soon as possible

COACHES MEETING: Coaches meeting will be held @ 9:00 behind the press box

TICKETS: Tickets will be sold at the door

- Adults = \$4.00
- Students = \$3.00

All coaches, athletes and managers are admitted free

ENTRIES: Schools will be allowed entries as per WIAA Regional Format

Each school may enter a maximum of:

- One entry in each relay event
- 28 individual entries for boys and girls
- There is a maximum limit of 3 in any individual event
- A school not using all eligible entries may not fill those after Thursday's deadline
- The number of entries per event can not change after Thursday's deadline
- An athlete may enter a maximum of 4 events, but no more than 3 running or 3 field events

For relays

- Schools must enter individual names and a seed time
- A maximum of 6 runners may be listed
- Being listed as a relay team member counts as one of the four allowed events whether or not the student participates
- Coaches have until the Clerk of Course checks in teams to determine which runners will compete

- Relay seed times should consist of actual running times of the athletes that you think will be running (coaches should estimate if necessary)

FACILITIES:

New London has a rubberized 400 meter track with 9 lanes in the straight away and 8 in the curves

1/4 pyramid spikes will be allowed on the track and runways

Shot Put and Discus is located on the north end of the track with only coaches and competitors allowed inside the fence

Pole Vault is located in the southwest corner of the facility

Long & Triple Jump is located at the south end of facility inside of the track

High Jump is located at the north end of the facility inside of the track

AWARDS:

Awards to be given:

- 1st place team trophies for Male & Female
- Combined Champion trophy
- Male & Female MVP trophies
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medals for all events

Trophies and awards will be announced as soon as the results are finalized

Coaches will be asked to report to the bullpen following the final race to nominate and select meet MVP's

A short awards ceremony will take place at the conclusion of the meet

PRIME TIME TIMING:

PT Timing will seed the meet, post heat/flight sheets, entry lists and results on line as soon as they are available

The entry window will be open from Monday, April 17th @ 12:00 until Thursday, April 20th @ 12:00

TRAINER:

A certified Athletic Trainer will be present throughout the entire day

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will be available at the stadium throughout the day

RUNNING EVENTS:

Running events will start @ 9:45

All runners in open events will be assigned a hip number and only anchor runners in relays will be assigned hip numbers

There will be no trials for running events

Sections will be conducted in the running events based on the “best times” with the slowest runners in the first section and fastest in the last section

FIELD EVENTS:

Field events will start @ 9:30

Top 9 will advance to finals in Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump, & Triple Jump

High Jump Starting Heights (*Subject to change based on the field*):

- Boys: 5’2”
- Girls: 4’2”

Pole Vault Starting Heights (*Subject to change based on the field*):

- Boys: 8’0”
- Girls: 5’0”

SCORING:

Team scoring will consist of eight places for individual events (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)

Team scoring will consist of six places for relays (10-8-6-4-2-1)

BULLPEN:

Please have athletes report to the bullpen on the first call

The bullpen will be located at the end of the track near the starting line (northwest corner of the track)

TENTS:

Team tents can be set up on the grass outside of the gate on the west side of the stadium that is located near the port-a-potty area

RESTRICTED AREAS:

Non-participating athletes and spectators will not be allowed inside of the fence surrounding the track

Athletes will not be allowed to linger on the grass inside of the track

Schools will be assigned to have coaches cover exchange zones in the following races:

400 Meter Relay
