Entries and Results: Registration opens on October 3rd. Go to www.pttiming.com. Click on *Upcoming Events* and go to *Woodland Conference Meet*. Click on *Register Online*, and follow the directions. Please indicate which eight (8) runners will be competing on the varsity level for both boys and girls when entries are made. Entry deadline is 12:00 noon on Tuesday, October 10, 2017. Coaches, you will pick up your runner's timing chips from the finish line area when you arrive, and, you are responsible for returning the chips to the concessions area after the race. Missing chips will be charged to your school.

Concessions and T-shirts: There will be a concession area selling a variety of food items, as well as short sleeve *Dry-Fit* T-shirts (\$15.00).

Awards: Championship bars to the winning school for boys and girls. Gold medals to the first 8 varsity runners (1st Team All-Conference), silver medals to the next 8 runners (2nd Team All-Conference), and bronze medals to the third set of eight runners (3rd Team All-Conference). The top 16 (8 gold, 8 silver) boys and girls JV finishers will be awarded medals provided by the host. The host school will bill the rest of the conference schools for their share of the cost of the JV medals.
