Entry Fee The entry fee is \$100 per team, \$200 for both men and women OR \$20 per runner if teams have fewer than 5 runners of either/both genders. The fee for unattached or open runners will be \$20.

Course The course is the same as the 2016 NCAA Midwest Regional Championship and was the course run for the 2015 NCAA Championship. It will also be the course for this year's 2018 NCAA Championship. The terrain is basically flat with some slight, gradual grades. The highest elevation is located where the start merges with the large loop. The lowest elevations are at the start/finish and the 1-mile area. The footing is smooth and generally firm throughout the course. Three eighth inch spikes are recommended.
