Please indicate which eight (8) athletes will be competing on the varsity level. **Entry deadline is 12:00 noon on Tuesday, October 9.** Teams who have already created a log-in can use that log in and will not have to re-enter their roster.

Finish Protocol: Please check the roster sheet in your packet and make any corrections. Please give this form to the PTTiming person located at the finish line by. All runners will wear a timing chip. PTTiming will provide video backup for the varsity races. No place cards will be handed out.

Restricted Areas: Any area roped off by the finish line and the area 5 yards behind the starting line is restricted. This means that only competing athletes and meet personnel are allowed.

Locker Rooms: There are no locker rooms available in Grant Park.

- Trainer:** A trainer will be located by the finish line.
- Awards:** Championship bars to the winning school for boys and girls. Gold medals to the first 8 varsity runners (1st Team All-Conference), silver medals to the next 8 runners (2nd Team All-Conference), and bronze medals to the third set of eight runners (3rd Team All-Conference). The top 16 (8 gold, 8 silver) boys and girls JV finishers will also be awarded medals.
Please have medal winners dressed in appropriate attire.
- Shoes:** Spikes can be a maximum of 1/2" in length.
- Wireless Devices:** The use of wireless communication devices (i.e., headsets, radios, cellular phones, etc.) Except by meet management and meet officials is **PROHIBITED**.
- Misc:** Please remind your athletes and fans that this is a cross country championship. Meet management would prefer that no footballs, frisbees, or soccer balls be brought to the park. Playing with these objects could interfere with the competition.
- Parking:** **Buses will not be allowed to park in Grant Park unless there is inclement weather.**
Please have them come back and pick up your team after the award ceremonies.
Remind parents that they may have to park on city streets if the parking lots in the park are full.
