## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

1. One team trophy will be awarded for each High School race.
2. Individual medals will be awarded to the top 10 in each race.
3. Please instruct your runners and spectators to help pick up after themselves and to keep the grounds free of trash. Our future use of this facility depends on how well we keep things clean as it is not a school-owned course.
4. Presentation of team and individual awards will take place immediately following the Girls' race near the finish line.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THREE LAKES SKI TRAIL:**

Coming off Highway 53, take exit number 110, which is the Highway 40 exit, into Bloomer. When you reach the bridge just past the high school, take a right onto Main Street. Travel two (2) blocks and turn left onto 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue. When you reach the stop sign, turn right onto Martin Rd. This is also County Highway SS. Stay on SS until you reach 110<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 110<sup>th</sup> street and then take a left onto 165<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The Three Lakes Ski Trail will be on the right just after you go over the first hill.

**Parking will be available on the road only.**
